**Y6 CRUCIAL CREW** 



Crucial Crew is an interactive, engaging, but also fun, personal safety educational provision managed by South Yorkshire Police, but delivered in collaboration with South Yorkshire Fire and Rescue and South Yorkshire Safer Roads Partnership.

Our year 6 children will be taking part in eight different scenarios during the day to learn how to keep themselves safe whether in the home or outside and the consequences of committing crime.

The children will be travelling to the Lifewise Centre in Rotherham, via coach. The coach will be leaving at 8.45am and the children will return to school ready for collection at the normal end of the day time.

Your child will need to wear school uniform, bring a waterproof coat, a water bottle and a packed lunch from home - those on free school meals will be ordered a packed lunch from school.

The main road can be extremely busy and dangerous for our children and we ask for your help to keep it as safe as possible for our children during these busy times.



# **OAKWELL RISE AWARDED ECO-SCHOOLS' GREEN FLAG**

PUPILS AT OAKWELL RISE PRIMARY ACADEMY HAVE ONCE AGAIN BEEN AWARDED A PRESTIGIOUS ECO-SCHOOLS' GREEN FLAG.

This academic year, we have once again received international accreditation for the children's exceptional work in promoting sustainability and raising environmental awareness amongst their peers.

The Eco-Schools programme, established in 1994, is now implemented in over 70 countries worldwide. In 2023-24, more than 1.4 million pupils attended an Eco-School in England. The programme follows a tried-and-trusted sevenstep framework, that encourages young people to explore a variety of environmental issues before spearheading environmental action in their school and local community.

This year pupils impressively built on these achievements by focusing on 2 key issues: biodiversity and our school grounds. The Eco-Committee then successfully delivered a diverse range of activities including developing our outdoor area in between the two play grounds, growing herbs in each classroom to create our own herb garden and gardening around school.

Since Oakwell Rise first engaged with the Eco-Schools' programme in 2022, accomplishments have included growing and caring for our own vegetable garden, planting our very own fruit trees and reducing our environmental footprint.

### 30 HOUR NURSERY FUNDING

Oakwell Rise Primary Academy is delighted to offer 30 hour funding for children either starting in Nursery or continuing their Nursery education into this academic year, 2024/2025.

We are able to offer the following:

- 30 hr funded places
- 15 hr funded places

The Nursery day will run as follows:

- AM session 08:30 11:30
- PM session 12:00 15:00

For the full time Nursery children, they will be an additional 30 minutes of lunchtime where children will need to be provided with a packed lunch from home. The lunch period will be inclusive within the offer and no further charges will be made.

Admissions to Nursery will be in order of the Date of Birth, regardless of whether you require 30 hrs or 15hrs. If you wish to apply for a 30hr funded place, you need to apply online at <a href="https://www.gov.uk/get-tax-free-childcare">https://www.gov.uk/get-tax-free-childcare</a> to receive an 11 digit code.
