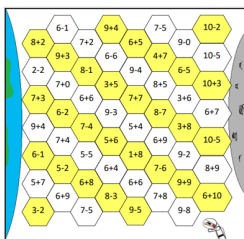
Reading

 $2 \times 2 =$
 $1 \times 5 =$
 $2 \times 5 =$
 $1 \times 10 =$

Can you do the inverse?
 For example if:
 $1 \times 2 = 2$
 then
 $2 \div 2 = 1$
