Admissions to Nursery will be in order of the Date of Birth, regardless of whether you require 30 hrs or 15hrs. If you wish to apply for a 30hr funded place, you need to apply online at <u>https://www.gov.uk/get-tax-free-childcare</u> to receive an 11 digit code.
