Barnsley Sport and Physical Activity Team are bringing the 2024 season of RampUP events to a close with a free CycleFest at Oakwell Stadium on Wednesday 30 October (10am-3pm).

The session will include ramps, bikes and scooters as well as a technical challenge course in the RampUP Zone. We'll be running two 'Learn to ride' sessions which must be booked in advance. The training is designed to help children take their first pedal strokes in riding independently without stabilisers, or just increasing their confidence on a bike.

In addition to the chance to ride bikes, there will also be the opportunity to have yours looked over with a free safety check carried out by the Barnsley Bike Works team, who can also advise on maintenance tips.

Your child can also get into the Halloween spirit and decorate their bike or scooter at the Spooky Spokes stall.



30 HOUR NURSERY FUNDING

Oakwell Rise Primary Academy is delighted to offer 30 hour funding for children either starting in Nursery or continuing their Nursery education into this academic year, 2024/2025.

We are able to offer the following:

- 30 hr funded places
- 15 hr funded places

The Nursery day will run as follows:

- AM session 08:30 11:30
- PM session 12:00 15:00

For the full time Nursery children, they will be an additional 30 minutes of lunchtime where children will need to be provided with a packed lunch from home. The lunch period will be inclusive within the offer and no further charges will be made.

Admissions to Nursery will be in order of the Date of Birth, regardless of whether you require 30 hrs or 15hrs. If you wish to apply for a 30hr funded place, you need to apply online at https://www.gov.uk/get-tax-free-childcare to receive an 11 digit code.

When you have received an 11 digit code please provide this to the school office by the 1st December for January intake.
