

# KS1 TERMLY NEWS


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A note from the Teacher

#### **Subject News**



In reading, we will be focusing on applying our phonic knowledge to support reading unknown words and developing fluency and reading speed.



This half term, we are writing recounts based on some fantastic traditional tales. The children will be focusing on using a range of conjunctions within their writing.



Within maths, KS1 are working on multiplication and division. We will be practising: practical, mental and written methods.



This half term, we have a range of STEM projects where we are going to be investigating and exploring lots of different questions linked to Chemistry, Biology and Physics



The Norman Conquest throughout the duration of the Spring term we will be focusing all of our historical learning on the Norman Conquest.



This half term, our learning will be focused on the artist Lyubov Popova. We will be creating abstract artwork using paint.

#### **Home Learning**

Each half term your child will recieve a homework grid with 6 different learning tasks linked to the curriculum areas - these activties are to be completed across the half term. As well as this your child will recieve a piece of maths and phonics / reading homework each week.

Your child will bring home a reading book and reading record daily, you and your child can share the story and fill in their reading record. Your child can swap their book daily - or as required.

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
