
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A note from the Teacher

In Reading sessions, we will be reading the novel The Pugs of the frozen North- this adventure story will whisk children off to the icy Arctic!



In writing sessions, children will be writing recounts. This will include working in past tense to retell sequences of events in chronological order.



In maths this half term, LKS2 will focus on multiplication and division. We will be practicing using both mental and written methods to problem solve.



In Science this half term, LKS2 will be learning all about sound. They will investigate how sound is made and how it travels to the ear through vibrations.



In History, children will learn all about the Anglo Saxons, Scots and Vikings, Children will then get the opportunity to go to the Jorvik Viking centre!



This half term LKS2 will be learning all about the Artist Vincent Van Gogh. We will be creating paintings in the style of the artist for 'Starry Night'.

Home Learning
