In writing, we are looking are developing our confidence writing CVC, CVCC words linked to traditional tales.



This half term, we are developing using a tripod grip with different tools. We are focusing on strength, coordination and balance for gross motor development.

In maths, we are learning all about using Malteasers to add and subtract.



We are focusing on developing our listening skills and understanding why listening is important.



Lots of learning will be linked into traditional tales, including learning about housing, bridges and different families.



This half term, we are learning about colour mixing and how to use different brush strokes.
