

In Reading sessions, we will be reading the novel The Guard dog, using our VIPERS knowledge to answer questions about the text.



In writing sessions, children will be writing non chronological reports, we will start by writing about squishmallows and then lego!



In maths this half term, LKS2 will focus on place value.
Children will be ordering and partitioning increasingly larger numbers.



In Science this half term, LKS2 will be learning all about the human body. We will learn all about exoskeletons, how our bodies work and move.
