


NURSERY TERMLY NEWS

In literacy, we are developing our awareness of sounds listening to where it comes in words and our production for sounds ready for phonics.



In maths, we are focusing on 1:1 correspondence within 5. Developing our confidence counting orally to 10.





This half term, we are developing our mark-making, creating small vertical and horizontal lines and drawing clockwise and anti-clockwise. For our gross motor development, we are looking at changing speed and direction and developing our balance and co-ordination.



We are focusing on developing our listening and attention skills and why it is important. We will develop our attention skills to focus on more than one thing at a time.



Lots of learning will be linked into 'Let's Celebrate'. The children will be exploring different celebrations and what they look like in different

This half term we will be focusing on control and precision with drawing squares and different shapes with different materials.
