Reading



In Reading sessions, we will be reading the novel Wonder, using our VIPERS knowledge to answer questions about the text.

Science



In Science this half term, UKS2 will be completing a chemistry topic. We will learn all about the properties of different materials.

Writing



In writing sessions, children will be writing non-chronological reports. These will focus on healthy lifestyles and the different things we can do to make good choices!

Geography



In Geography, children will learn all about different settlements. We will learn about how we trade different goods such as silk, spices, chocolate and coffee.

Maths



In maths this half term, UKS2 will focus on the four operations. Children master their use of written methods for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.
