Reading



In Reading sessions, we will be reading the novel *Holes* by Louis Sachar and we will be using our VIPERS knowledge to answer questions about the text.

Science



In Science this half term, UKS2 will be completing a physics topic. They will be learning about moving objects and the forces that act upon them.

Writing



In writing sessions, writing a variety of genres and for different audiences and purposes. These will include *La Luna*, *Before Sunrise*, and *Theco Fossil*.

Geography

Maths
