### Reading



In Reading sessions, we will be reading the novel Goodnight Mister Tom, using our VIPERS knowledge to answer questions about the text.

### Science



In Science this half term, UKS2 will be completing a physics topic. They will be learning about electricity and circuits.

### Writing



In writing sessions, children will be writing narratives and recounts. These will focus on Midas Touch, The Saga of Biorn and The Alchemist's Daughter!
